Laura is a former early childhood educator and is a Fellow of the Tulane University Early Childhood Policy Leadership Institute. She serves a trainer for the Juvenile Justice and Mental Health Curriculum, Adverse Childhood Experiences presentations, and Results-Based Facilitation. She recently co-authored a childcare training curriculum for the Louisiana Department of Education on Early Brain Development.

Laura holds a BS in Early Childhood Education from Louisiana Tech University, MS in Family Life Education, and MA in Counseling and Guidance. She is certified in the areas of early childhood education and counseling guidance with the Louisiana Department of Education. She is also a Licensed Professional Counselor Supervisor, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, and National Certified Counselor.
