Ochsner LSU Health Shreveport

In 2021 leaders from Ochsner Health and LSU Health Shreveport named **David L. Callecod** as Interim Chief Executive Officer of Ochsner LSU Health System— North Louisiana.

Callecod brings more than 25 years' experience as a healthcare CEO. From 2008 to 2020, Callecod led Lafayette General Health System, which merged with Ochsner Health in October 2020. The seven-hospital system includes the only two teaching hospitals in the Acadiana region, Ochsner Lafayette General Medical

Center and Ochsner University Hospital & Clinics, and an additional six clinical affiliate hospitals.

Under his leadership, University Hospital & Clinics (UHC) was recognized as "Best Place to Work in Healthcare in 2019" by *Modern Healthcare*. UHC and Lafayette General Medical Center both received the 2019 Women's Choice Award for "Patient Experience" and the Women's Choice Award for "America's Best Hospitals for Outpatient Experience". Lafayette General Health System also received multiple "Best Places to Work" awards including *Becker's Hospital Review* and *Computerworld* during Callecod's tenure, among many other national awards.

Prior to his time in Lafayette, David was CEO at Central Arkansas Health System.

Callecod received a B.A. degree from Wabash College in Crawfordsville, Indiana, and a MBA from Indiana Wesleyan University.




