## City of Shreveport's Mayor



**Tom Arceneaux** was sworn in as Shreveport's 57th Mayor on December 31, 2022. Mayor Arceneaux is a graduate of Captain Shreve High School, LSU and LSU Law School and has spent much of his adult life in Shreveport.

He is an attorney practicing for many years with the Blanchard Walker O'Quin and Roberts Law Firm. He has been active in civic affairs, especially as an advocate for the Highland neighborhood where he lives in a home he restored with his wife, Elizabeth.

A devoted community leader, Mayor Tom has been passionate about Highland Restoration Association and AMIKids for many years. He was chosen as a member of the Captain Shreve Circle of Honor. Tom has served on many community organization boards, including the Shreveport-Bossier Mayors' Prayer Breakfast, the Shreveport Little Theater, Holy Angels Residential Facility and the Legal Services of North Louisiana.

The former two-term city councilman and former assistant city attorney is well known in Shreveport. In a Shreveport Times op-ed by Prentiss Smith when Tom announced his candidancy, Smith shared: "He has long been considered to be one of our community's best and brightest. He is a political technocrat and someone who has earned the respect of his peers as being thoughtful and deliberate."

Tom has been a member of our Rotary Club since 1994, for 29 years! He has served on many of our committees—chaplaincy, music, sgt at arms, fund-raising, as well as other committees over the years. He served as club president in the Rotary year 2007-2008 and is a Major Donor to The Rotary Foundation.




# Thanks to our 2022-2023 roster back cover sponsor !
