Gingerbread House

Jessica Miller, a Shreveport resident for 27 years, received her Bachelor's degree in biological sciences from LSUS, her MA in general counseling and guidance from LA Tech and her MBA from Centenary College.

For almost 20 years she has served as CEO of the Gingerbread House Children's Advocacy Center, Louisiana's busiest child advocacy center which provides critically needed services for child victims of sexual abuse, severe physical abuse and child sex trafficking in the nine parishes in Northwest Louisiana.

Jessica serves on the Steering Committee of the I-20 Central Corridor Anti-Trafficking Team, the Commu-

nity Response Team Expert Trainer Panel and the U.S. Attorney's Louisiana Human Trafficking Task Force. She also serves on the board of Forensic Nurse Examiners of Louisiana. In 2019 she was appointed to the Louisiana Governor's Human Trafficking Prevention Commission and Advisory Board.

Alex Person received her associate's degree in broadcast journalism from BPCC, her Bachelor's degree in family and child studies from LA Tech and her MS in non-profit administration and leadership from LSUS. She is a Certified Family Life Educator. In 2012, Alex joined Gingerbread House as a Forensic Interviewer and Education Coordinator. In 2020 she became the Director of Education and continues to serve as a Forensic Interviewer.

She has also been trained in Human Trafficking, Delayed Disclosure, Victim Recantation and Interviewing Reluctant Children. Alex has had the opportunity to train with Homeland Security on interviewing skills.

Alex serves on the Board of the Junior League of Shreveport-Bossier and enjoys family time and volunteering. She and her husband

(Rotarian John David Person) have two children.

Gingerbread House received a civic grant from us in 2022 for \$4,500 to help with their programs.

Having our meetings on Zoom now has helped him maintain that 100% as well.

He suffered the cardiac arrest when he was serving as the club's Secretary—Treasurer and was sitting at the head table at our Rotary Tuesday meeting. We were using a head table on the stage at that time and Gene collapsed at the beginning of the meeting. There were three physicians in attendance that day who quickly sprang into action and started CPR and saved him. Needless to say, the scheduled speaker was upstaged!

The Rotary Foundation is near and dear to Gene as he is a polio survivor. He is a Major Donor to the Foundation and has attended a couple of the Rotary International Conventions.

Thank you, Gene, for being such a wonderful inspiration for us.
