2022 Prize Fest Is Coming!



Gregory Kallenberg will join us again next Tuesday to tell us about 2022 Prize Fest that will start on Friday, October 14th. Over \$100,000 in cash and prizes will be awarded in five creative disciplines—film, food, music, fashion and comedy.

He founded Prize Foundation in 2012 with the goal of elevating creative entrepreneurship in Northwest Louisiana and the state as a whole.

Kallenberg is the Louisiana Endowment of the Humanities' 2019 "Champion of Culture" and is a former journalist.

Prize Fest presents a one-of-a-kind experience to the spirited crowds, filling the days and nights of Prize Fest with short film screenings, live music, exemplary cuisine and cocktails, fashion runway exhibitions and a live comedy show.



SATISFY MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

From Constitution of the Rotary Club of Shreveport, Louisiana, Article VI, Section 3, "Adult persons of good character and good business and professional reputation, (a) engaged as a proprietor, partner, corporate officer, or manager of any worthy and recognized business or profession, or (b) hold an important position in any worthy and recognized business or profession or any branch or agency thereof and have executive capacity with discretionary authority, or (c) having retired from any position listed in (a) or (b) ...

INVITE TO A MEETING

(first guest meeting is free for qualified potential new member) By attending a meeting, the potential new member will have a better understanding of our club, what we do and the obligations.

SUBMIT PROPOSAL

(Obtain from Executive Director)

Send completed proposal form to Rotary office or give to Executive Director.

CLASSIFICATION COMMITTEE APPROVES Classification Committee reviews proposal for qualification for membership. If approved, committee determines proposed member's classification and submits to the Board for final approval.

ROTARY BOARD APPROVES

Proposals are submitted to the Board via email for email vote that is ratified at monthly Board meeting.

PUBLISHED IN ROTARIPOST

The name of the proposed member and proposed classification is published to the club members in the Rotaripost.

PAYMENT OF INITIATION FEE AND DUES

If no written objection is received by the Board of Directors within 7 days following publication, the proposed new member and proposer are notified and an invoice for appropriate fees is issued.

NEW MEMBER ORIENTATION SESSION Upon payment of fees, a date is selected for an orientation and introduction to the club. The new member attends an indoctrination with a Past President prior to introduction.
