Garry Kim Green, MBA, MHA, FACHE, is the administrator of Shriners Hospitals for Children-Shreveport. He came to “the first Shriners Hospital” in 2002, having previously served as senior assistant hospital administrator at LSU Health Sciences Center (now University Health).

A native of West Frankfort, Illinois, Kim earned his Masters degree in health administration at Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis. He then earned his MBA, as well as a B.S. degree in health information management at Louisiana Tech University. He is a Fellow in the American College of Healthcare Executives and is a Registered Health Information Administrator in the American Health Information Management Association.

He is a past president of the Northwest District of the Louisiana Hospital Association and past member of the Board of Trustees of the LHA. He is a published author and is involved in many community programs in the Shreveport-Bossier City area.

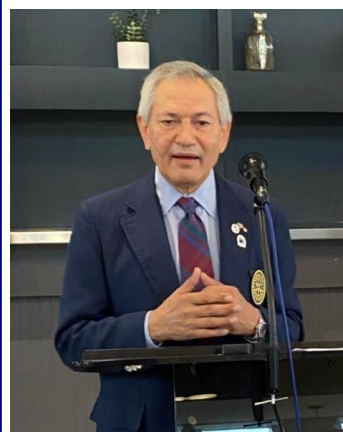

Our 2022-2023 Rotary District Governor **Feico Kempff** visited with us recently and presented a theme banner “Imagine Rotary” to President Mark Snow.

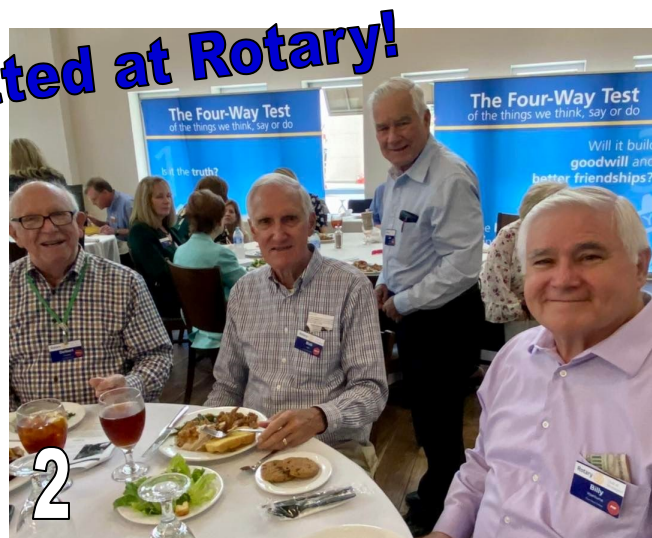

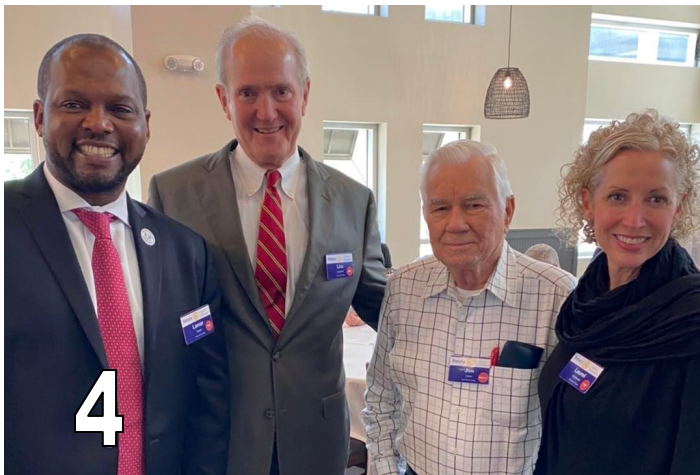
