Rabbi Sydni earned her B.A. in music from Swarthmore College and received her ordination and M.A. in Rabbinic Studies from the Ziegler School of Rabbinic Studies. Between degrees, she spent two years engaging in intensive exploration of Jewish text at the Pardes Institute of Jewish Studies in Jerusalem.

She especially enjoys teaching, learning, reading, writing and chatting about Jewish approaches to self care, the status of women in Jewish law, and Biblical notions of love of God.

You may also find her spending time with her husband and best friend, Rabbi Feivel and their two dogs Buddy and Jax.
