Louisiana Tech University

President Les Guice has dedicated five decades of his life to Louisiana Tech University. He came to Louisiana Tech as an architecture student in 1972 and earned his degree in 1976 while gaining an appreciation for engineering that would guide his future career.

During his career at Louisiana Tech, Dr. Guice has served as Dean of the College of Engineering and Science, Vice President for Research and Development, and Executive Vice President. He was named Tech's 14th President in 2013, after showing unwavering commitment to and leadership for his alma mater.



Dr. Guice has guided the development of programs that have elevated the University's academic, research, and innovation programs to national prominence. He developed several advanced technology research centers and entrepreneurship initiatives, and initiated programs to support intellectual property, commercialization, and partnerships with government and industry partners. These activities and partnerships culminated in the establishment of Louisiana Tech's Enterprise Campus.

He is a native of Monroe and grew up in Bastrop. He and his wife, Kathy, have three sons—Kyle, Chad and Bret—and five grandchildren.




Upcoming Shreveport Green project October 8th—8:00-11:00 1034 Sprague St., Shreveport, LA 71101
